

Connected Communities Strategy

As you are aware, our school has been selected to implement the NSW Government's Connected Communities Strategy. This is a significant beneficial strategy for Airds High School.

An Executive Principal position is unique to the Connected Communities strategy, due to the high-level educational leadership expected, especially with the work required to form productive and effective partnerships and agreements with local government and non-government service providers. As Airds High School has been selected, the Principalship level in our school was changed and advertised.

Following the 10-day appeal period, Mr McGuire has been offered and accepted the position as Executive Principal. Mr McGuire will be undertaking a period of leave and will assume the position as the Executive Principal on Monday the 22nd of November 2021.

Mr McGuire is an experienced principal who has demonstrated exemplary commitment to students through improving learning and wellbeing outcomes at the level required of an Executive Principal. He has also demonstrated his capacity to work closely with staff, parents and the wider community to build effective community engagement. Over the next few weeks, Mr McGuire will transition into the Executive Principal role.

The current Director of Educational Leadership, Mr Clayton Reedie, as well as a Director Educational Leadership – Connected Communities will be working with Mr McGuire to ensure a smooth transition as the new Executive Principal.
